# WHY ROOFING SAFETY MATTERS

Roofing remains one of the top three deadliest occupations in North America. From fatal falls to heat stress, roofers face hazards every day.



## Fatality Rates Are Exceptionally High

In 2021, roofers in the US experienced 59.0 deaths per 100,000 workers—over 16 × the national average of 3.6 per 100,000 employees.



## Falls Account for the Vast Majority

Roughly 81 % of all fatal slips, trips, and falls industry-wide occur from elevation. Roofing falls cause nearly half of all fatal construction-trade injuries.



## Fall-Related Death Rate Exceeds Other

In 2017, roofers suffered 36 fatal falls per 100,000 workers, 10 × higher than other construction trades combined.



## Top 3 Deadliest Occupations (2023)

Even as overall construction fatalities declined slightly, roofing still ranks among the three most lethal trades—most due to slips, trips, and falls from height.



## High Non-Fatal Injury Rates

OSHA (2023) reports 9.6 fatal injuries per 100,000 full-time construction workers; roofing's non-fatal injury rate hovers around 5-6 recordable cases per 100 workers—well above the private-industry average of 2.4.



## Heat Stress & Weather Hazards

In 2022, roofers comprised a disproportionate number of worksite heat-related illnesses—especially when temperatures exceed 35 °C (95 °F).

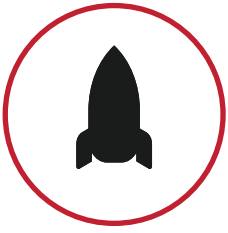
